

The Wolf Ridge Press Poetic Medicine Poetry Prize

This poetry book series honors the poet who has grappled with experiences connected with illness and recovery. We welcome manuscripts from patients, caregivers, witnesses, and healthcare professionals. One chapbook-length manuscript will be published each year.

Deadline: September 1 postmarked.

Manuscript Guidelines

Manuscripts must be typed and single-spaced, no more than one poem per page, and binder-clipped.

Suggested length is 20-36 pages.

Include a page listing only the title and a second title page with title and contact information. Your name should not appear anywhere else in the manuscript.

Do not include acknowledgments. Poems previously published are eligible for inclusion but not manuscripts previously published in their entirety.

Concurrent submissions are permitted as long as we are notified if your manuscript receives another award.

Please do not submit revisions during the course of the contest. Winning authors will have an opportunity to make modest changes before publication.

The publication of the winning manuscript will be 500 copies with 50 copies to the author in lieu of royalties. Additional copies may be purchased by the author at cost. The winning poet will receive a prize of \$500.

This award series is open to all authors writing original works in English for adult readers.

The editors at Wolf Ridge Press will judge this competition.
